South Korea's Son is Messi and Ronaldo rolled into one

Manchester: When Son Heung-min went down clutching his face in a recent Champions League match, the pain was not confined to the Tottenham striker's fractured eye socket. The shockwaves were felt all the way back in his homeland of South Korea, where the nation collectively teared the worst ahead of the World Cup.

Son is his country's Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo wrapped up into one. He is an immense source of national pride — having established himself as one of the leading football players in the world — and the greatest hope of success going into Qatar. His injury in the match against Marseille was big news back home, with one publication describing it as 'Korea's big emergency.'

BARCELONA REVEALS

Lewandowski and Pique sent off as Xavi Hernandez's men rally past Osasuna 2-1

With an improbable win, Barcelona made sure they will go into the World Cup break at the top of the Spanish league standings. Robert Lewandowski was shown his first red card in nearly a decade and Gerard Pique was sent off from the bench in his last career match, but Raphinha scored late as Barcelona rallied to defeat Osasuna 2-1 and secure the Spanish league lead ahead of the World Cup stoppage. Lewandowski's second career red card came in the first half of Tuesday's victory, which left the Catalan club five points ahead of Real Madrid. Madrid, who have a game in hand, endured its first league loss of the season — 3-2 at Rayo Vallecano on Monday. The defending champions will host relegation-threatened Cadiz on Thursday. Pique was sent off for complaining to the referee following the half-time whistle. The veteran Spain defender had made Xavi Hernandez's squad even though he had far fewer appearances at the Camp Nou at the weekend after announcing his retirement from football. Lewandowski, who hadn't been sent off since 2013 while still playing for Borussia Dortmund, was shown his second yellow card in the 51st minute after going hard into the body of Osasuna defender David Garcia away from the ball.

Even without "Kvara," Napoli earn 10th straight win

second-place Atalanta this past weekend, after scoring six goals and assisting on five more in the opening 12 rounds. Napoli also weren't slowed by an injury lay-off for Serie A's leading scorer Victor Osimhen (eight goals) earlier this season. Midway through the second half at the Stadio Diego Armando Maradona, Osimhen earned a penalty and Lozano converted from the spot. Lozano then drew a foul from Empoli defender Sebastiano Luperto, who picked up his second yellow card — leaving Empoli with 10 men. Lozano — preparing to play for Mexico at the World Cup — was again troubled with strong work down the right flank, muscling his way past defenders to provide a cross that Piotr Zieliński redirected in with one touch in the 88th minute.

Damsgaard goes from WC joy to penalty pain

Mikkel Damsgaard went into Brentford's English League Cup match on Tuesday on a high after being called up to play at the World Cup for the first time. The Denmark playmaker was brought back down to earth. The 29-year-old Damsgaard struck what proved to be the decisive spot kick against the crossbar as Brentford lost 6-5 to fourth-tier Gillingham in a penalty shootout in the third round.

Radical amendments to be incorporated in IOA's constitution during SGM

NEW DELHI: The Indian Olympic Association is set to incorporate a slew of radical amendments in its constitution, including equal representation of male and female members with voting rights in its General Assembly, during its SGM here on Thursday. Faced with the suspension threat from the International Olympic Committee coupled with the directives of the Supreme Court, the IOA has no other way but to bring the changes to its constitution. It is expected to be just a matter of formality for the IOA to adopt the draft constitution — already approved by the IOC — prepared by the SC-appointed retired apex court judge L. Nageswara Rao. The SC has approved holding of IOA elections on December 10.

IPL auction to be held on December 23

NEW DELHI: The players auction for the next year's Indian Premier League (IPL) will be held in Kochi on December 23, a BCCI official said on Wednesday. The Turkish city of Istanbul, Bengaluru, New Delhi, Mumbai and Hyderabad were also in contention to host the auction but, the BCCI eventually opted for the coastal Kerala city. Logistically, and considering the dates, Kochi turned out to be the most suited option, a BCCI official said. Unlike the last auction, this year's will be a mini auction. The 10 IPL franchisees have already been asked to submit their list of retained players by November 15.

Singhra secures Paris Paralympics quota

AL AIN (UAE): Double Paralympic medalist Singhra Athana secured a quota for India at the 2024 Paris Paralympics after signing off at the fourth place in the P1 — men's 10m Air Pistol SH1 event at the Para Shooting World Championships here on Wednesday. The 40-year-old Indian, who won a silver and a bronze at Tokyo Paralympics last year, was in little contention as he led for a major part of the event until a score of seven spoiled his medal chances. ISL: Hyderabad beat Jamshedpur

JAMSHEDPUR: Hyderabad FC registered their fifth successive win this season as they edged past Jamshedpur FC 1-0 to consolidate their top spot in the Indian Super League (ISL) here on Wednesday. Mohammed Yasin scored again for the defending champions in the second half to end their winless streak against the Red Miners. The hosts made four changes to the side that lost to FC Goa in the last match.

Narwal stars in Bulls' win

PUNE: In-form Bengaluru Bulls took their revenge on Haryana Steelers with a 36-33 win in their reverse game and climbed to the top of Pro Kabaddi League table here on Wednesday. Haryana took a big risk in the match, keeping in-form Ramesh Meeta on the substitution bench in place of Vinay and Bulls made them pay for the crucial error. Naeem Narwal stole the show for Bulls, earning nine points, and setting up the win for his team.
